Subject: Advisory on Outdoor Major Surgeries in Medical Camps for Registered Medical Practitioners in Gujarat State

- Prior to conducting major surgeries in outdoor settings, registered medical practitioners are encouraged to consult with relevant healthcare authorities and experts to ensure compliance with established medical standards and guidelines.
- 4. While recognizing the potential benefits of medical camps in expanding access to healthcare services, registered medical practitioners are reminded of their duty to prioritize patient safety and quality of care in all medical interventions.
- The Gujarat State Medical Council shall disseminate this advisory widely among registered medical practitioners and healthcare institutions through official channels, emphasizing the importance of exercising caution and professional judgment in the conduct of outdoor major surgeries.

We urge all registered medical practitioners involved in conducting outdoor major surgeries in medical camps to adhere strictly to these guidelines and prioritize patient safety at all times. Your commitment to maintaining high standards of medical care plays a crucial role in promoting public health and well-being across Gujarat State.
